



ST. JOHNS COMMUNITY DOG PARK RULES OF CONDUCT

- Park Hours: Sunrise to Sunset
- All dogs must be currently licensed (with tags and collar on) and current on all vaccinations.
- Dogs must be healthy and with no known history of dangerous behavior.
- No female dogs in heat are allowed in St. Johns Community Dog Park.
- Up 2 dogs per adult per visit allowed.
- Keep dog's leash in-hand at all times.
- Dogs 35lbs and under MUST utilize the smaller run.
 - Dogs over 35lbs MUST utilize the larger run area.
- The owner/custodians MUST be 17 years of age or older.
- No one under the age of 13 is allowed inside St. Johns Community Dog Park
- Youth 13-16 years of age MUST be under strict adult supervision at all times.
- Dog feces MUST be cleaned up by the dog owner/custodian IMMEDIATELY.
Bags are provided for dog waste.
- Holes dug by dogs MUST be filled in by the dog owner/custodian before leaving the park.
- Dogs showing aggressive behavior must be leashed IMMEDIATELY and removed from the park. NO MOUNTING ALLOWED.
- Spike or pinch collars should be removed while dogs are in St. Johns Community Dog Park. Remove any metal choke chains or link collars. When playing, other dogs maybe injured by these types of collars and the owner would be responsible for all injuries.
- KEEP ALL GATES CLOSED AT ALL TIMES!

PROHIBITED:

- Human & Dog Food/Treats
- Glass Containers
- Smoking
- Puppies (under 4 months)

Do NOT bring dogs with known aggressive tendencies into St. Johns Community Dog Park!

IF your dog inflicts an injury to another dog or owner/custodian, give your name and phone number to the other owner/custodian before leaving the dog park.
